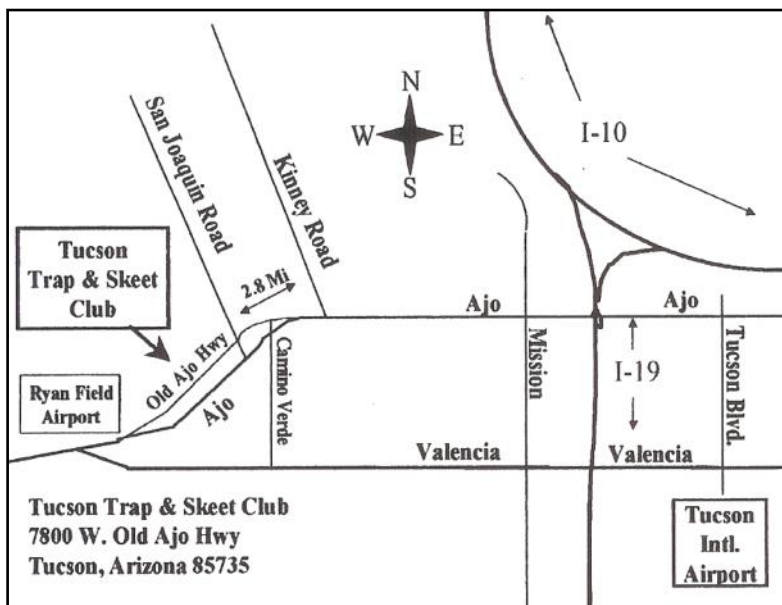

Shoot Information

Daily Fees: ASTA—\$3.00, ATA — \$3.00, WZ —\$1 .50 per/100

1. This shoot has been authorized by the ATA and will be conducted in accordance with ATA and Zone specific rules. John Bergman, the Arizona ATA Delegate, is in charge of classification and will ensure targets are set per ATA Rules. Please be sure to have your Average Card up to date for proper classification.
2. Arizona Residents must be current ASTA members.
3. There are no target requirements or Class advancements for this shoot.
4. Classification, squadding and cashiering will open at **2:00 PM on Thursday , July 13** and 7:00 AM daily thereafter. Practice trap is available each day beginning at 7:00 AM.
5. ASTA club trophies & Added Money open to all winners. **Please note: For Club Trophies, AAA and AA will be combined into one Class.** Shooters will still be classified per the table below for Zone Wide purposes.
6. Special Category shooters (as defined by ATA rules) **must** make their declaration when they are classified. That designation cannot be changed for the duration of the tournament. ATA Rules for All American Point shoots apply.
7. Refreshments and food will be available in the clubhouse.
9. New York Style White Flyer Targets will be thrown. Picking up empty shells from the ground during or after shooting is not permitted.

TROPHIES AND ADDED MONEY

Trophies and Added monies have been contributed by:

ATA Zone added money of \$3,000 will be distributed on the 400 HAA Championship targets via the Lewis Class method (five classes, 60/40 per class). All shooters, Zone residents and non residents who shoot the HAA are eligible. The Western Zone Secretary will mail checks to the winners.

The ASTA has contributed \$4,160 Open Added Money to be awarded in all Club events. Added Money follows the trophy.

The ASTA has contributed the Club trophies for this tournament. All trophies will be shells for Events 1-6.

Zone Wide Trophies provided by the ATA and the Western Zone. ATA and Western Zone Wide trophies will be shipped to the winners by the trophy vendors. Please make sure your correct address is on file with the ATA.

SHOOT REPORTING AND RESULTS

Event scores for all clubs will be uploaded directly to the Western Zone website shootatazone.com at the conclusion of each event. Zone Wide scores can be viewed and you will be able to determine high scores in class, category, handicap or state after each event. Shoot management will also post data from the website in the clubhouse. If you have internet access or a web enabled phone, you will be able to check all scores after each event at the Zone Wide Leaderboard.

SHOOTOFFS AND TARGET BANKING

Friday

Class winners will not be advanced for succeeding events. Class Singles and Doubles Ties will be carried over to the respective Championship Events. For Class Day Handicap (Event 2) any shooter in contention Zone Wide will begin banking targets.

Saturday

Shooters with 200 straight will begin banking targets promptly at the conclusion of the event. In 25-target sub-events.

Special category and Class shooters should remain on the grounds until they know if they are involved in a shoot off or in contention for a Zone Wide trophy.

Sunday

Shooters with 100 straight in Doubles or Handicap will start banking targets as soon as possible. Doubles will be shot off in ten (10) pair sub-events. Handicap will be shot off in 25-target sub-events. Ties for Club trophies will be shot off at this time also.

Do not leave the grounds until you are sure of your Zone Wide status.

HOA and HAA

HOA shoot-offs will consist of 20 singles, 20 handicap and 5 pair of doubles targets, repeated if necessary.

HAA shoot-offs shall consist of 20 singles, 10 handicap and 5 pair of doubles targets, repeated if necessary.

Zone Wide All American Points Pins

Where there is no Trophy awarded and eligible contestants are tied for AA Points Pins, ties will be decided by their reverse score on the events in question on full sub events. If ties still exist, shoot management may resolve ties by coin flips or other gaming methods.

PURSES AND OPTIONS

Purses and options are not compulsory. No changes or withdrawals will be allowed after the event has started. No part of option money is held out. Pay-off sheets for events 1-4 will be posted and the payoff sheet for events 5 & 6 will be mailed. It will be the responsibility of all purse and option winners to report their winnings to the IRS. Checks not cashiered within ninety (90) days will become void.

SCORES

Scores are final for purse and option calculation one (1) hour after event is completed. Subsequent to this deadline, scores will be corrected for ATA record purposes only.

ATA 100 and 200 STRAIGHT PINS

Shooters breaking one hundred or two hundred straight without carryover will be eligible for an ATA 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any individual. Please inquire at the Trophy Room.

The Tucson Trap & Skeet club will also be offering their "Thunderbird", a beautiful silver and turquoise pin, for a 100 straight in any scheduled 100-target event. This is a one-time award and previous winners are not eligible.

SHELLS

The club will have most popular loads for sale by the box or case. Rental of vendor space does not constitute authority to sell shells on the grounds.

SOLICITING

No soliciting, selling of chances, or similar activities will be allowed on the grounds, nor shall any literature of any kind be distributed on the grounds without prior written approval by the ATA and Club.

SALES AND DISTRIBUTION

No soliciting, selling or distribution of shot shells or any types of goods or wares is allowed on the club premises without express written permission of the Tucson Trap and Skeet Club. Violators will be removed from the premises. This rule will be strictly enforced.

CAMPING

Tucson Trap & Skeet Club has full hookups with 50 amp service at all pedestals. Reservations are required for all shooting events and may be made by calling 520-883-6426, ext. 255, or sending an e-mail to the RV Coordinator at rvinfo@tucsontrapandskeet.com. Fees are assessed on a per shoot basis only. **Please check in with the RV desk upon arrival and before setting up.** The Club reserves the right to change RV locations in the event of unforeseen problems beyond our control. Evidence of a sticker must be conspicuously displayed in the window of your RV.

By the act of classifying and participating, each shooter has indicated they assume and accept full responsibility for themselves and their minor children, for bodily injury, death, or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of inherent risks and dangers.

This Program will govern the Tournament. The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided for. Management reserves the absolute right, in its sole discretion, at any time prior to or during this Tournament to change or modify the program in any manner it desires. The management reserves the right to refuse any entry or disqualify any one who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.
